## What the Media Gets Wrong

The left blames the right, the right blames the left,  
and the rest of us are left blaming ourselves  
for believing that any of this shit makes sense.

### Who Controls your Thoughts? (it's not you)

The two biggest forces that shape how we think are (1) the politicians who run the system and (2) the media that filters everything we see. And neither one is looking out for us.

Both groups are owned, financed, and controlled by groups with their own agendas – and keeping you confused, angry, and divided is their business model. Once you understand who they really answer to, the strategy becomes impossible to ignore.

### They're only Looking out for Themselves.

Most political conversations focus on the scandals, the headlines, the manufactured outrage of the week. But all of this are just symptoms of a larger problem... we are electing people who don't represent us.

Their loyalty isn't to the voters – it's to the donors, lobbyists, and special interests who fund their campaigns and keep them in power.

### Stop Wasting your Time.

This is why we don't watch the news anymore. Why should any of us waste our time? The news doesn't inform us – it agitates us. That's the business model. It's the same recycled garbage designed to keep us dumb, angry, and distracted. Worthless noise. Manufactured outrage. Performative screaming.

### I'm done going along with the scam.

I'd rather focus my anger and resources to solving our issues - and not just bitching and stressing out. This is just one simple example of how Congress puts their benefactor's interests above yours.

A stressed-out population has great benefits to Big Pharma – which has 2 lobbyists per rep. They don't want you happy and living within your means. They want you broke and troubled, because that's what brings in the cash.

### Media + Congress = Money & Power.

And the two parties know EXACTLY what they're doing. It's a circus designed to keep you distracted while the people in power rob you blind.

Every headline is just bait to keep us arguing about pointless bullshit to keep us divided. Division is their business model. If Americans ever stopped fighting each other long enough to look up, we'd notice who's actually screwing us – and their whole racket would collapse.

### The Past doesn't Matter. It's Time to Move on.

And honestly, we don't give a shit how this mess started or which party screwed it up first. None of that matters when the foundation itself is broken. Nothing will change if we keep re-electing the same two parties and the same career politicians who caused this disaster in the first place.

### Fix the System or Nothing Changes.

Until the system works, the issues don't matter. It's futile to debate any issue until we fix the core problem. We can argue about healthcare, immigration, foreign policy, taxes – all day – but it's pointless if the people making those decisions aren't actually representing us.

### We're Asking the Wrong Questions.

It's frustrating to watch the news and see all the attention focused in the wrong direction. We MUST stop getting direction from the media and start thinking for ourselves.

When we think for ourselves, we think one way... but when we think on behalf of society, we think the complete opposite.

### The Big Picture Is Ignored (on Purpose).

The media talks about the symptoms of our problems, but they ignore the disease. The level of “getting to the root of a problem” is a three when it should be a 10.

They don't talk about what's most important like the motivations or intentions behind issues. They only report on trivial topics, like what Trump lied about today. Look, we know he lies. Even his supporters know he lies. How the hell is this news?

Here's another example. Trump just submitted a motion for an appeal. The news is analyzing the merits of the arguments. But the goal of the motion is not to get a win or even make a legal point. He just wants to delay the trial, so he needs to invent reasons to justify his excuses.

It doesn't matter what those arguments are. They are just made-up, but the news and podcasters only focus on the details, which are meaningless. There needs to be more news coverage about what is preventing this change... which we all want and know that we need. Transformational change. Not fake incremental change. This is the most important issue. Period.

### We only need a Few Outlets to Ignite this Movement.

## Timing is Perfect to Start a New Party

We fought a Revolution against a Monarchy for Independence -  
now we must fight against our 2 parties for Freedom.

### This is a truly Unique Opportunity to take back Control of our Government.

Right now, there's a once-in-a-generation opportunity for third parties and candidates.

Congress is effectively split, which forces their members to vote how they are told. This presents a unique opportunity for independent candidates.

Just a few independent members can have the swing vote in nearly every partisan decision. Then, we alone would determine the next Senate Majority Leader, House Speaker, committee members, chairmanships and much more.

We can use this power to pass our first three goals; Ranked Voting, Term Limits and Equal Campaign Laws.

It is our desire to build a coalition with a small number of intelligent, serious candidates who would like to run for national office under a new party, perhaps the Reset Party.

By having the deciding vote on every close bill, we would be able to negotiate extraordinary terms for the residents of their respective states.

This is real power that is currently not available to the residents of their states and is not possible with current Democrat and Republican legislators.

### Who are the "Crazy" ones?

Candidates who belong to one of the 2 parties are considered to be "legitimate candidates", yet they are the ones who sell us out to stay in power.

But 3<sup>rd</sup> party candidates – who are looking out for you – are called the "Crazy Ones." Can someone please explain this?

In 2006, Mike Jingoian was persuaded by many people to run for President. (Yes - peer pressure got the best of even him.) But as soon as he did, the same people called him "crazy" for doing so.

This is why so many independent candidates enter races and then step out, just to step back in. And, due to this uncertainty, the candidate appears foolish and unreliable in the eyes of the public. This is not because of the candidate's indecision. It is the result of voters not thinking for themselves.

When you're not running, people encourage you to enter the race, but, as soon as you do, the same people say you're "crazy".

This is because when we think for ourselves, we think one way, but when we think on behalf of the herd, we think another.

Many of these unconscious psychological pressures are covered in the book, *Mistaken Beliefs*.

If you disagree, let us remind you that 80% of Americans want term limits, but they re-elect the same corrupt politicians over 95% of the time... with record low approval ratings!

This is herd mentality engineered by the 2 parties to stay in power... and it works magnificently!

### Who are really the “Crazy Ones?”

1. Voters who fight for your rights or
2. Voters who re-elect the same politicians over and over, and hoping that they suddenly start doing the right thing and expecting unicorns to show up at their front door.

### The High Cost to Bribe and Mislead the Public.

Independent candidates have one more advantage... we don't need to raise much to run a successful campaign.

The amount of money that 3rd parties spend per vote is a fraction of what the 2 major parties need to spend to bribe and mislead voters.

These figures are from 2016.

- The average cost per vote for a 3rd party candidate was under \$3.00.
- The average cost per vote for a two-party candidate is hard to know. The amount of money spent that is reported is about \$20-25 per vote.

However, this figure does not include dark money which is now in the billions. The total amount spent is somewhere between \$20 – \$100 per vote.

Apparently, it costs much more money to run a campaign if you lie and cheat.

### Your Money goes a Long Way.

Imagine if you gave 3rd parties just 1% of the money you contribute to the 2 parties.

With this tiny amount, independent candidates can spread their message to our entire population. Then, you can take the remaining 99% and spend it on buying Congress a conscience... express delivery!

This is the greatest threat to the Democrat and Republican parties and the biggest opportunity for the American People.

### They're Laughing at us Right Now.

They're reading this message and saying there's no chance that this is going to take hold because the American People are too stupid, too distracted, and too lazy to vote us out.

## Suing Congress and the Two Parties

We are Suing the 2 parties for blatant Conflicts of Interest against our Constitution and the American People.

### What is Conflict of Interest?

“The basic criminal conflict of interest statute, 18 U.S.C. § 208, prohibits government employees from participating personally and substantially in official matters where they have a financial interest.”

A conflict of interest occurs when an individual's personal interests – family, friendships, financial, or social factors – could compromise his or her judgment, decisions, or actions in the workplace.

### Reset America vs. The US Congress

Along these lines, we are creating a Go Fund Me campaign to raise funds to sue Congress for blatant violations of conflict of interest against the Constitution and American People.

The foundation of our Constitution is built on maintaining balance of power and prohibiting conflicts of interest.

Yet, the laws that affect Congress are written and passed by the members of Congress themselves... making this the greatest conflict of interest in the history of our nation, and perhaps the world.

When our Constitution was written, there was no word for “career politician”. It was never considered a possibility that someone would serve in government for more than one term.

Whether you are a strict constitutionalist or not, you must agree that the law is on our side.

This is taken from our book, Mistaken Beliefs (written about decade ago.) Take for example Senator Joe Manchin (Democrat). He was recently chairman of the Senate Committee on Energy. This is the top position in ensuring we pursue more climate-friendly policies - and he is adamantly against addressing global warming.

Do you think that it has anything to do with the fact that he owns a coal company, Enersystems, and last year alone, he was paid \$492,000. Or that he receives the most funding in the senate from the oil and gas industry?

Here are the different types of conflicts of interest that apply to our case.

1. Absolute Immunity
2. Election Laws
3. Fundraising
4. Personal Benefits

### 1. Absolute Immunity

Congress gave themselves absolute immunity from being sued or prosecuted. This means that no member of Congress can be brought to justice for actions that we would be convicted for.

This protection is broader than just “qualified immunity” which is what you may already be familiar with, for example police. Here are some of the crimes that fall under absolute immunity.

They openly violate their own laws and oaths.

- They ignore subpoenas & court orders.
- They hire family members and people unqualified to do their job.
- They use fake and biased data.
- They hold financial interest in matters before the legislature, i.e., insider trading.
- They have outside income interest.
- They receive gifts and honoraria.
- They disclose nonpublic info for personal gain.
- They use public funds and employees time to run campaigns.
- They don't follow standard accounting rules when determining data like: unemployment, GDP and the debt. If we use the same accounting practices that Congress uses then we would be in prison for life.

But since **both parties** violate these rules, neither party objects.

## 2. Election Laws

The 2 parties create steep hurdles that prevent the names of 3rd party candidates from appearing on ballots. Many of these are illegal. Here's one example.

Gathering signatures is hard work and the 2 parties know this. This is precisely why they require an unreasonable number of signatures just to get the names of candidates on ballots.

What's more, the number of signatures required by 3rd parties can be up to 10 times more than those required by the Democratic and Republican Parties. Are you okay with this?... because we're not!

In addition, people are scared to give out their personal information to strangers at a time when cyber-crime is exploding. And if just one signature is wrong, then the entire sheet is thrown away. Who is this meant to benefit?

3rd parties are constantly suing states and the federal government to defend against illegal campaign practices that prevent competition. Over the past 10 years alone, there have been over 100 lawsuits brought by 3rd party and other independent groups.

These cases are seldom lost, but most are thrown out by judges whose careers are influenced by their decisions since they were appointed by Democrat and Republican governors.

But after collecting signatures and suing the government, there are no funds left for the important activities that the Democrat and Republicans take for granted, like fundraising, promoting candidates, outreach, candidate development, volunteering, media development and so on and so on.

## 3. Fundraising

Every year, the 2 parties give the super-rich more ways to buy their influence. There seems to be no limit to how much they will sell you out for their own benefit.

The cost of re-election campaigns (for “both sides”) is skyrocketing – so both parties must raise even more money to keep up with fundraising from their opponent. Of course, this means selling out our nation even faster.

Fundraising regulations are a maze of loopholes that can be interpreted different ways depending on which rules are exploited by which party.

For example, the limit that one may contribute to candidates is \$3500 per election, On the other hand, one individual (Elon Musk) gave Trump \$250 million. If you can't explain this, then you're not alone.

The Supreme Court case, Citizens United, removed all limits on how much one can donate to campaigns and opened the door to unlimited dark money.

Now, the superrich can spend funds to influence elections without voters even knowing where the money came from. Are you okay with not knowing who is paying to buy your vote and how much?

#### 4. Personal Benefits

Congress has the easiest job in the world. They don't hold real jobs. They don't struggle to make ends meet. They don't sit in traffic. They don't get searched in public places.

They make a minimum of \$174,000 a year and get paid while campaigning.

They pass laws that exempt them from accountability to personal responsibility.

- They aren't held accountable when they leave office for the terrible policies and have no consequences when they spend money we don't have.
- They have zero oversight or accountability.

- They have no performance reviews or checks and balances of any kind.
- They get a generous expense allowance that covers everything from first class air travel to free access to elite gym memberships.
- They travel around the world with family and friends, paid for by debt spending.
- They're given gifts, meals, attendance at events and vacations from lobbyists.
- They get outstanding life and health insurance and free out-patient care.
- They get full life-time retirement benefits after just five years of service with a premier retirement package that extends much farther than social security.
- They have a 2 day work week. Members of Congress typically arrive in Washington on Tuesday night and fly home Thursday evening.
- They get free printing and postage for sending mass mailings to voters and full-time staffs who are dedicated to win re-election campaigns.

- Their arguments aren't based on facts or principles.
- They're crafted to please the sponsors who keep them in office.

**How can we expose their hypocrisy?  
Let's put them to the test.**

### We can ask them questions like these:

- Will you support a bill for term limits?
- Do you think that the two-party monopoly is really working?

2. **Ranked Voting...** to eliminate the spoiler effect so voters can vote for who they want,
3. **Equal Rules...** to give 3<sup>rd</sup> parties a fair chance to compete with career politicians like yourself.

According to polls, **80% of voters already want these changes**, so we at Reset America, don't need to convince them of anything new. We are merely offering voters a **guaranteed plan** to give them what they **already know** we need.

## Our Foolproof Plan

1. Voters in Oregon elect Mike Jingoian to Congress. This is easier than it sounds.
2. He will introduce bill(s) to pass these three changes to our election laws.
3. You will ignore them. (We're hopeful but not delusional.) So, we sweeten the deal.

Early supporters will receive better terms - so you are **incentivized to pledge your support early...** like phased term limits, more benefits, direct payouts and golden parachutes.

4. Then, we keep increasing these incentives until we have enough votes.

We only need a majority to pass. Not to mention, there are also many current legislators who already support these reforms, including **MOST** former members of Congress and **ALL** former US Presidents.

Here's the magic behind this plan. This strategy is **guaranteed to work since this is how all laws get passed.**

[We hate to have to pay our “leaders” to do what’s right, but this is the system that you built. Regrettably, sometimes you must play the game in order to win it.](#)

In times like these, leadership isn’t measured by speeches, but by courage, moral clarity, and the willingness to do what is right even when it is difficult.

Our political system is collapsing. Do you really want to be a member of a party with the lowest approval ratings in our nation's history?



### 16. Competition is Urgently Needed

#### Turning Crisis into Opportunity

I'm done being polite about it. The 2-party monopoly is dog shit. It's outdated, unsustainable, and embarrassing. Our problems are soaring, and the effects are catastrophic.

But believe it or not, that's actually good news for us - because systems this broken are easier to replace than to repair. When a building has crumpled, no amount of repairing will work. It must be torn down so that it can be replaced with something special.

#### Valid Solutions are Covered Up

Here's why this matters most. There are more than just 2 positions on every issue. There are practical solutions to **all** our problems (that don't cost anything), but they're hidden because they don't help incumbents get re-elected.

War, sickness, pollution, debt... these mean big profits for the mega-rich. But peace, getting healthy, living within our means... these do not increase profits which they use to pay politicians to get re-elected. They say they're fighting for you, but they're really fighting to keep their jobs.

#### Many Election Problems Need Fixing

There are many issues with our elections that need fixing - or at least debated - but there is no point in going into detail about these possibilities since no Democrat or Republican will ever consider changing our election laws.

Quite the opposite. Any discussion about changing our laws is intended to make the situation even worse. This is only what's possible under an honest, democratic election process and why we must quickly adopt the Reset Plan.

#### Possible Changes to our Election Process

- Abolish signature gathering and replace it with an on-line system
- Abolish Gerrymandering
- Address the Electoral College problem
- Implement Recall Elections
- Rewrite Campaign Finance Laws
- Restrict Lobbying and Corporate Influence
- Introduce National Referendum Questions
- Reigning in the Expansion of Political Powers
- Implement same week National Primary so that all votes are counted and counted equally.
- Limiting the power of the President. With every term, the Office of the President assumes more control and becomes more powerful.
- Redefining the role of the House and Senate leaders, e.g., one person should not decide which bills are voted on. If legislators holding senior positions affect all people, then all people should elect them. These positions have more power than the President since they can stay in power until they choose to retire.
- Create an independent citizen's commission to make the rules that affect the members of Congress including their powers, compensation and rules regarding conflict of interest.

### No Fair Competition

They always say, “competition is great for everyone”, but they take extreme steps to prevent it for themselves. It’s unethical, it’s illegal. In fact, Congress breaks the same laws that they themselves created that make what they do illegal. Are you okay with this?... because the rest of America is not.

And it works. With the lowest approval ratings in our history, they achieve a ridiculously high 95% re-election rate! And now that voters are dumping the 2 parties, career politicians are terrified and they’re making election laws even more unfair, if that’s even possible.

### No Motivation to do the Right Thing

They have no reason to do anything different, because they’re getting exactly what they want... a near perfect re-election rate and absolute immunity. So, it doesn’t matter how bad they are. They know that they’ll be re-elected (no matter what you think of them) because they get to make the laws, including ones that directly affect themselves.

### The Root Problem Egregious Conflicts of Interest

The root problem is that laws that affect congress should not be made by congress itself. This applies to dozens of crimes that would send you and I to prison, but the worst of these are election laws, since this is what keeps them in power.

### We’re Suing Congress – Join us

Btw, we’re suing Congress for blatant violations of conflict of interest against our Constitution and the American People. **Hop on Board!**

## 17. Good People eager to Serve

There are qualified individuals who are willing to put honesty and integrity about personal interests, favors, and perks. These are people who stand for our nation in its truest sense. They are professionals in all walks of life. They are business leaders, educators and scientists. They are devoted citizens who haven’t been corrupted by the Washington swamp. But they will never be seen or heard of under our current corrupt 2 party monopoly.

### They are:

- Concerned citizens and Neighbors that could use our help and support.
- Candidates who are not beholden to lobbyists, special interests, and the rich.
- Patriots eager to create the change that is urgently needed at this time in our history

### They are not:

- The same corrupt career politicians who created the very mess that we are in today.
- People who willingly cave to special interests, lobbyists, and corporate pressure.
- Puppets of the Democratic and Republican Parties.
- Career politicians whose only goal is to maximize donations to pay for increasingly expensive re-election campaigns.

Let us examine these 3 changes to our election process in more detail.

## 18. The Reset America Plan

Reset America isn’t just a slogan.  
It’s a real plan.

We have a **100% foolproof plan** to persuade congress to pass the following changes. How’s that, you ask?... since we all know that no self-serving career politician will ever vote to lose their job.

Simply put, we will use the same unethical and illegal practices that Congress uses every day, but instead to work for us! It’s clearly explained on our website.

### The Reset Plan will achieve the following:

1. Term Limits to elect people who are not for sale to the highest bidder.
2. Rank Voting so you can vote for who you want without the risk of getting your opponent elected instead. This is called the spoiler effect.
3. Equal Rules and Laws to give outsiders a fair chance to get elected. Everyone wants 3rd parties, but you need to know the rules are different for us.

Here's the real brilliance of this plan. This plan does **not require** you to vote for 3<sup>rd</sup> party candidates... *at least right now*.

Why's that!!! Let's face it. You wouldn't anyway. 3<sup>rd</sup> party candidates don't stand a chance of being elected until we first pass rank voting, along with term limits and equal rules. All 3 pieces are required to put an end to the poisonous mistaken belief... "voting for a 3<sup>rd</sup> party is a wasted vote."

### Voters are already demanding these changes

The good news is 80% of voters already want these changes, so we don't need to convince the public of anything new. We are just offering a foolproof plan to give everyone what they already know we need. We just need a few dollars to make it happen.

And though everyone wants these changes, voters still don't know how critical these changes are to protect our future. That is the purpose of this chapter.

Now let's examine the benefits of these 3 changes in more detail.

## 19. Term Limits

[We don't need a law that lets us do something that we can do without the law.](#)

In researching the data for this book, I was both impressed and frustrated. I am impressed that the American People already know that we need this to happen.

If 80% of voters want term limits, then why do we re-elect the same candidates over 95% of the time, when there are legitimate 3rd party candidates on the ballot? (Many of these unconscious behavioral influences are covered in Mistaken Beliefs.)

A president can only hold their office for two terms, but no such law exists for Congress or judges. This proposed change in our election laws is already incredibly popular, even in our current divisive political environment.

80% of voters (from "both sides") are demanding these reforms. Keep in mind that this number only reflects those who vote.

These are another 40% of people who don't vote because they are already checked out. But however you look at it, the numbers are on our side.

The bad news is that our current class of career politicians would never pass this since they oppose Term Limits.

Their argument is, "**Hey... if voters don't like us, then they can vote us out.**" But they know that's impossible because of the many unfair advantages they give themselves.

Politicians know that the American people want Term Limits, so during their campaign they support them. But when they are in office, it's an entirely different story.

This is especially true for the President who desperately needs Congress on their side and won't propose anything that will threaten their relationship.

- Candidate Trump argued Term Limits would help him "drain the swamp" when elected, much to the delight of his anti-establishment base.
- President Obama supported Term Limits and argued that foreign leaders should limit their time in power to provide "new blood and new ideas" in their countries.

However, both of them changed their positions as soon as they were sworn in as president - and the Democrats didn't pursue this issue even when they had the presidency and a majority in the House and Senate... Surprised?

### Benefits of Term Limits

- Since legislators can't run for re-election, they don't need to raise as much money (i.e., collect more bribes) to fund their re-election campaigns.
- Term limits will encourage Congress to stop avoiding dealing with serious issues and encourage them to make unpopular decisions which are now ignored because of retaliation from voters.
- It will motivate members of Congress to "seize the day" while they still can to make a positive impact to our country – and before there's more time to sell-out to special interests.
- It will create equal footing for members within their party and eliminate the good old boys club.
- No member of Congress will have any special position, seniority or rank thereby ensuring that all members have equal influence in the policies that shape their districts and our nation.
- It will weaken the influence of lobbyists and special interest groups. With a high turnover rate, lobbyists will have less time to buy members of Congress and Congress has less reason to be bought.
- Politicians lose touch with the people. By cycling leaders in-and-out of office more frequently, Congress will be represented by people who know what life is really like in their communities.
- It will encourage a new generation of leaders, with new ideas, techniques, and technologies to tackle a new generation of problems and threats.

- With Term Limits, the era of the career politician is over. We all know the phrase "power corrupts"... and with the power now gone, corruption is not far behind.

Here's another reason why we need Term Limits. It's nearly impossible to beat an incumbent, so when a seat opens up, there is a rare opportunity for the "other side" to gain a seat. Realistically, there's no other opportunity when one side can take power from the other. This motivates current legislators stay in office longer than they would like since they don't want their seat to be taken over by the opposing party.

### Duration of Terms

Personally, I feel that a senator should only serve one 6-year term. This will encourage them to get as much done as possible, without spending all their time running re-election campaigns. It will give them no incentive to sell out for campaign contributions and much less time creating ties with lobbyists and special interests. A congressperson should only be able to serve 3 two-year terms (6 years in total) for the same reasons.

Lifetime appointments for judges are also a problem. There are currently about 800 federal judges that have lifetime appointments. This policy was enacted 238 years ago when life expectancy was much lower, plus it leads to mental debilitation, lack of accountability and, most recently, high-stakes confirmation battles in the Senate. Despite all this, the US is the **only "democratic nation" that has lifetime appointments for judges.**

## 20. Ranked Voting

But just replacing career politicians isn't enough... The vacancies will still be filled by the 2 parties so nothing will change. People won't vote for who they really want because they may take a vote away from someone else who has a better chance of beating the person they hate even more! This is what we call the "spoiler effect" and this leads to the lessor of 2 evils.

So, there's another thing that we need, and like Term Limits, it's another change that most of us already know that we need and that's providing competition to the 2 parties... Again, this is not a hard sell since 2/3's of the public already want 3rd Parties.

The solution to the spoiler effect is Ranked Voting. This is where you vote in order of your preference... so if the person you like has the lowest vote count, then your vote goes to the next person on your list. This way you can vote for who you really want and not risk electing your opponent.

### Different Voting Methods

There are different types of voting methods. The type of voting method influences who we vote for. Obviously, this shouldn't be the case. We should vote for who we want to elect, but in reality, this is not the case. The worst voting method is the one called, Past the Post (or winner takes all.) As you can probably guess, this is the one that we use today. There are 2 common ways to conduct voting for an election. They are Past the Post and Instant Run-off Voting, now called "Ranked Voting".

#### 1. Past the Post

(This is what we currently use)

How we cast our votes also affects who we vote for. We vote using a 2-party single-vote system. But, over time, this system always ends up with people voting for the "lessor of two evils". There's even a mathematical reason for this. Also, past-the-post is responsible for producing the spoiler effect which prevents people from voting for who they really want and helps get unpopular candidates elected by 'splitting the vote".

[It doesn't matter how we got into our current situation. It doesn't even matter who is to blame. All that matters is what we do from here.](#)

#### 2. Rank Voting

(formerly called instant runoff voting)

Rank Voting is a far better method to conduct elections. With Rank Voting, you vote for any and **all** the candidates you like – in the order that you like them. If you're ideal candidate doesn't have enough votes, then those votes go to the next candidate on your list.

### [The Spoiler Effect is Real and with Rank Voting, it's a thing of the Past.](#)

This way, you can vote for anyone you want without any risk of taking votes away from another candidate who has a better chance of beating the candidate that who you hate even more than the one you want to see elected.

In 2000, Ralph Nadar helped George Bush get elected because he took enough votes away from Al Gore in the swing state of Ohio. Even worse, winner-take-all voting can produce winners that a majority of voters don't want. Candidates can squeak into office only because two or more rivals split the opposition. This occurred in the 2016 Republican primary when Trump received only 8.4% of his party's vote. But with ranked voting, the winner would have needed to receive over 50% of the vote. X<sup>1</sup>

### Here's how Ranked Voting works

1. Voters rank the candidates for a given office by preference on their ballots.
2. Ballots are counted. If a candidate collects a majority of votes (that is, over 50%), then that candidate wins.
3. If no candidate won an outright majority, then the candidate with the least number of votes is eliminated and the votes that were cast for that candidate goes to the next person on your list.
4. The process is repeated until a candidate receives a majority of votes (50% or higher.)



## 21. Equal Campaign Rules & Laws

Donald Trump said that the system is rigged.  
That might be the one thing he said that was true.

I'd like to stop with Term Limits and Ranked Voting, but there's one more equally important change that we must make and that's Equal Rules.

The easiest way to be re-elected is simply to not allow competitors. But nothing in our government will change until competition is injected into the process. Without healthy competition, the 2 parties will continue to destroy our country and our way of life for their personal gain.

Our election process has been so poisoned over the years by the 2 parties that "reform" is not enough. It needs to be reset.

We need a system ...

- Where the rules are the same for all parties and candidates.
- That doesn't give incumbents huge advantages to help them win re-election.
- Where all parties have the same access to the resources and events that the 2 major parties have monopolized for years.
- That removes all conflict-of-interest in our election rules and process.
- That is not manipulated so horribly that we end up with 95% re-election rate with a horrible 10% approval rating.

### Unfair Advantages of Career Politicians

Incumbents win 95% of the time. How is this possible when their approval ratings are at historic lows? Well, when you consider who makes the rules, it's no surprise at all. 3rd party candidates don't stand a chance against career politicians who will break any law to gain an advantage.

When we think about unfair election laws, the ones that come to mind most often are unreasonable signature counts and not being invited to the debates. However, there are many more disadvantages. There is a list of these disadvantages in the table titled, Unfair Advantages for Incumbents. This document can be found on our website and in our book, Mistaken Beliefs.

In my experience, the greatest disadvantage is how money is forced to be spent. All the funds raised by 3rd-party candidates is spent on collecting signatures... just to get a candidate's name to appear on a ballot.

There's never any money left for promotion, attracting qualified candidates, recruiting people with marketing and fundraising, podcasts and videos, building a volunteer army, helping candidates run and fundraise, and so on and so on. I have had enough of this... have you?

If any candidate meets all the requirements to run for office, then they should be given the same opportunities as the Democrats and Republicans.

Is this too much to ask?

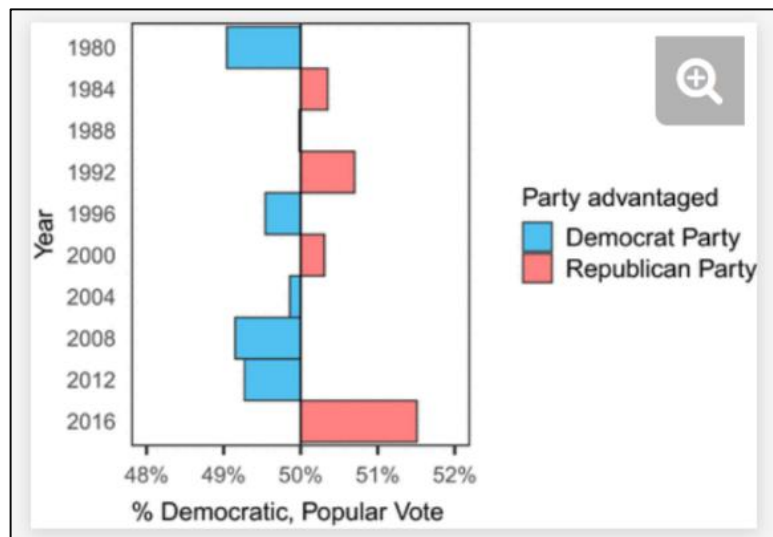

## 1. The Electoral College

I'm often if I want to end the electoral college.  
With regards to our goals at Reset America,



the answer is No.

Our goal is to elect people who will have an honest conversation about our options and what's in our best interest. We already know the issues both for and against the electoral college. The purpose of this book is not to promote my personal opinions on this or any other issue.

The electoral college is not a Democratic or Republican issue because both parties have wanted to end it at different times. The last serious attempt was in the late 1960s. It was a bipartisan effort, and it was even backed by Republican President Nixon, but it was killed in Senate.

This chart shows how the electoral college has benefited each party since 1980. These values show how much of a percent advantage that each party had for each election. As you can see, the Democrats benefited by the electoral college in 5 elections and the Republicans in 4 elections. Now, it's the Republican Party that benefits from it and doesn't want to see it abolished.

**Which party benefits the most from the Electoral College?**

The graph represents the range of the national popular vote for which one party would win the Electoral College without a popular vote plurality. X<sup>3</sup>

There are 3 reasons why it hasn't been abolished.

1. There's always one party that is benefiting from it and doesn't want to see it go.
2. There's no lobby called the "get rid of the electoral college lobby" that sinks millions of dollars into re-election campaigns.
3. With a 95% re-election rate, the system is working perfectly as is. Why change a thing?

All political scientists agree that the electoral college serves no useful purpose. It is solely a political issue. This is proven by the fact that, at one time or another, both parties have wanted to end it. Public opinion polls have shown that the majority of Americans favored abolishing it by 81% in 1968; and 75% in 1981. X<sup>4</sup>

Even today, with all of our partisan bickering, a full 61% of Americans still believe we should abolish the electoral college. X<sup>5</sup>

It never occurred to our Founding Fathers that our country would grow into a nation with 50 states and that the electoral college would still be in effect. If the delegates were voting today, the electoral college wouldn't even be considered. Unfortunately, as we've learned, it's become much harder to update the constitution than our Founding Fathers had anticipated.

As a matter of fact, the electoral college was an afterthought. All the important issues were settled, particularly passing the Declaration of Independence. It was the last day of a weekend, and the delegates were rushing to get home with the big news. A small number of delegates kept the issue alive. The majority were not in favor of it, but they were tired of debating and let it pass. Their attitude was, "we're giving future generations the ability to update the constitution as they see fit. So, what harm could there possibly be in passing it?"

### [The National Popular Vote Interstate Compact](#)

There's a serious movement in the works to abolish the electoral college. It's called the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact.

The agreement calls for states to award their electoral votes to the winner of the national popular vote once enough states join the agreement. So far, 15 states and the District of Columbia have approved the pact. This represents 196 electoral votes of the required 270 to win the presidency. By doing this, the electoral college will be nullified.

## 2. Campaign Finance Laws

Every year, the 2 parties give their wealthy benefactors more ways to buy their influence. There seems to be no limit to how far they will go to sell out our nation for their own benefit.

Another reason is that fundraising (on "both sides") is skyrocketing – so both parties must raise even more money to keep up with fundraising from the "other side". Of course, this means selling out even more.

Note The details reported in the chapter were written following the 2016 campaign. It will be updated at some time in the future. However, by then, I'm certain that that the data will be even worse than reported here.

I'd like to stop for a minute and check in with you. If you've gotten this far then I thank you. I'm hoping you're finding this information eye-opening. If there's something that I could be saying differently or doing better, please let me know.

The next topic you'd like to discuss is campaign finance. Let's start with a few definitions...

### Hard Money

These are donations to individual candidates that are often called hard money. Hard money has firm restrictions and is highly regulated when it comes to how much can be donated, where it can be spent, and on what. Soft money has no such restrictions. So, to bypass these restrictions, soft money donations became the prominent form of political giving. X<sup>6</sup>

### Soft Money

Soft money is donated to political parties and political action committees (PACs) where the purpose is not to promote a specific candidate. Soft money is mostly unregulated, and there is no limit on how much can be given in exchange for influence. The PACs can spend it on whatever they want as long as it fits a generic objective to "increase the vote." It became very popular after the Federal Election Campaign Act (1974) placed restrictions on how much money people could donate to campaigns.

### Dark Money

The 2 parties have now decided that permitting soft money is not bad enough. Encouraging people to spend more money to bribe them is pretty sweet - but what if we allowed them to be anonymous as well. This way, the people won't know where the money's coming from in the first place." Welcome to Dark Money.

The Supreme Court case, Citizens United removed the limits on how much you can donate to campaigns and which opened the door to dark money.

Such organizations can receive unlimited donations from corporations, individuals and unions. What's worse, the super-rich can spend funds to influence elections without voters knowing where the money came from. X<sup>7</sup> Do I really need to say that we should know who is paying both parties to influence public opinion and elections?

There are many ways to change our campaign finance laws. But like other details in this book, it's just a waste of time to discuss these if we just keep electing the same corrupt individuals over and over.

The situation is "effectively a form of legalized money laundering and it is something that we've seen on both sides," says Brendan Fischer of the Campaign Legal Center.

Since the Federal Election Campaign Act, the amount of money that campaigns received has mushroomed. During the 1992 election, there was less than \$100 million in soft money used by political parties. By the 2000 election, this amount had reached \$750 million. In the 2012 and 2016 elections, nearly two billion dollars were collected in direct campaign contributions, and the 2020 elections appear to be on track to continue or increase that number. X<sup>8</sup>

### Are you as Confused as Me?

You may be confused about how campaign contributions work. I'm sure you know that there's a limit on how much a person can contribute to a political campaign. But we also know that the elite can donate millions while being completely anonymous. How can there be such a contradiction? Here's how it works.

The maximum amount that a single person can donate to a politician is \$2900 per election. However, there's a tiny loophole. If we give our money to someone – except a specific candidate – then there are no limits to how much you can "donate". This is called soft money and it's mostly paid to political action committees (or PACs). PACs get away with this because PACs don't promote a specific candidate – but the money CAN be used to bash an opponent. So naturally, this little loophole is the reason why we see so many negative campaign ads.

### Both Parties work the System Equally

Both Donald Trump and Hillary Clinton took great advantage of this soft money system. When, for example, Clinton's main joint fundraising committee received a contribution, it divvied the money up among her campaign committee, the DNC and a gaggle of state-level Democratic Party committees. State Parties then shifted the money from Clinton's joint fundraising committee right to the DNC, allowing the national committee to pocket significantly more cash than federal contribution limits would allow.

Republicans did the same, an even higher percentage of the time: Republican state parties shifted more than 90% of the dollars they received from the Trump Victory committee to the Republican National Committee. X<sup>9</sup>

### 3. Our Constitution has been Perverted

Our constitution was adopted in 1787. It was not meant to last forever. In the brilliance of our forefathers, it was meant to be a “living document” – to see what works, what doesn’t and change it to reflect the times. They provided mechanisms to allow us to update it and even take back government if it no longer represents the interests of the people. It was even suggested that all laws should revert back to the way they were for each generation so that they would have the chance to govern themselves as they see fit.

#### There are Two Problems with our Constitution

##### 1. Our Constitution is very Old

First, it was written over 235 years ago. There were no states, just colonies and citizens associated with their colony and not the federal government. It was written in a different time with different ideas, different challenges, and different threats. They did not foresee 13 colonies becoming 50 states and 14 territories. There was no plumbing, electricity, telephones, roads, television, spam, satellites, nuclear weapons. It would be a full 78 years before slavery was banned.

Does it make sense to let our society get destroyed because we’re forced to obey a document that was written over 235 years ago?

## 2. Our Constitution has been Corrupted

Even worse, they did not expect that government would be poisoned by career politicians who rig the system for their benefit and who would have no chance of being re-elected if elections were fair.

They did not foresee taxes, dark money, gerrymandering, standing committees, filibusters, insider trading, social media, tribalism, gaslighting, disinformation, the expansion of powers, lobbyists, net neutrality. There is no mention of any of these issues because they did not exist.

As a result, the laws surrounding these issues were made by Congress and the 2 parties. It should be no surprise that both parties manipulate the system to force out competition. How else can they maintain a 95% re-election rate with a 10% approval rating?



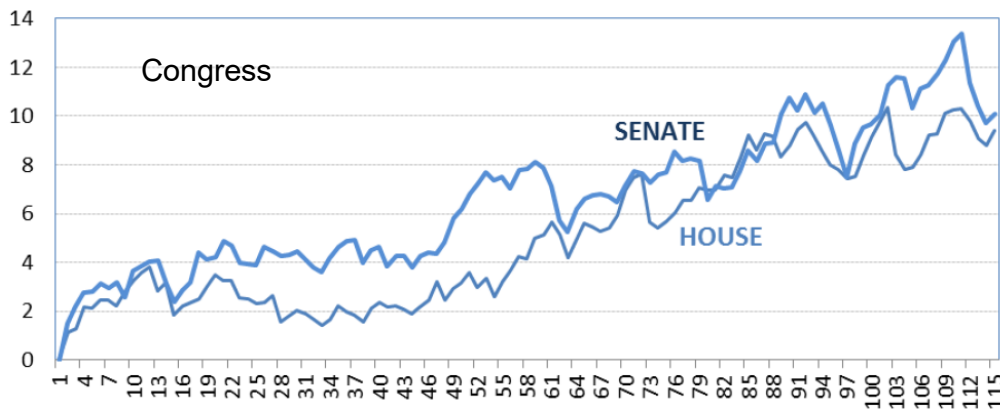
### 45. Rise of the Career Politician

In fact, if you want any chance to win an election for Congress or Senate, then you need to move to a state that has an open seat. Then, once elected, you spend all your time working on your next re-election campaign.

This graph shows the average number of years that a person serves in Congress. Notice how re-election rates continue to rise while approval ratings continue to drop. In what plane of existence does this make sense?

**Practice Makes Perfect**

Experience creates success. In the book, *Outliers*, Malcolm Gladwell explains that when a person repeats the same task over and over, they become excellent at doing it.

Do the same task for 10,000 hours and, congratulations, you're the best in the world. Politicians are no different.

They have their 10,000 hours talking about change while they vehemently protect the status quo.

If politics were an Olympic sport, then they would win the gold every time.

Anytime a politician makes a speech, people tell me, "Wow, he's so different. He's nothing like anyone else in Congress" ... Yeah right! The truth is that they all sound this good.

They're masters at saying one thing and doing another – and separating themselves from the problems that they themselves created - then selling themselves as the only ones who can fix those problems... as well as the failed system that they themselves also created. And around and around we go.

### Gerrymandering

We're expected to write our names, addresses and phone number and give it to a complete stranger who's waving it around on a crowded sidewalk. Sounds fair.

---

Outsiders have no such advantages.

---

Outsiders have to campaign while trying to keep a job, earn a living, support their families and pay taxes.

---

It's easy for incumbents to raise money.

- A politicians life revolves around fundraising. (It costs a lot to keep getting re-elected when 93% of people want to throw you out.)
- From giving jobs to the highest contributors to selling government contracts, it's easy for incumbents to raise lots of cash for favors.

Independent candidates struggle to raise every dollar.

---

2-party candidates have a (pick your decade)... gang / staff / team / homies / possie / crew. They consist of advisors, handlers, telemarketers, PR staff, data analysts, social media directors, speechwriters, volunteer coordinators who are all highly motivated to succeed because all of their jobs depend on getting their boss re-elected.

Outsiders need to recruit, hire, and pay salaries for qualified help. It's difficult to find volunteers who are as motivated as people who will loose their jobs if they fail.

---

Experienced marketing consultants can take a poor service record and make it sound like they were the greatest human being who ever lived. They have speechwriters who create perfectly worded talking points; so, getting an honest answer to a question is impossible. Each response has one goal, to get re-elected.

3rd party candidates are generally honest. They won't tell you what you want to hear simply for votes and cash.

---

They have employees whose job it is to help constituents in exchange for votes. They find lost Social Security checks, do favors for the elderly and veterans. At election time, they announce all the great things they'll do for you, as soon as they are re-elected. Then, all of these promises are forgotten.

All of the outsiders' employees are imaginary.

---

Career politicians already have a successful team... one that they built over many years. They do not need to recruit, interview or hire a single soul. But not only do they know and trust them, but they also know the skill sets for each employee, how they manage deadlines and so on. There's no risk.

Outsiders must start recruiting and hiring from scratch. There is also a high turnover rate since politics attracts problematic individuals. Many have attention issues which results in them quitting after just a few weeks. It can be a full-time job managing staffing issues alone. (We learned this the hard way.)

---

It's not just the politicians who lose. If they're not re-elected, then the entire world around them is upended (vendors, consultants, lobbyists, contractors, fundraisers. Therefore, all these people vigorously fight to keep their benefactor in office.

Outsiders are expected to lose, so no one's lives are affected.

---

They get invited to more events than they can possibly attend. They are honored in parades, city events, anniversaries and are invited to make speeches at graduations, conventions, and large gatherings.

Outsiders need to beg for these invitations and speaking opportunities.

---

They have media experts that produce reports and videos. These are sent to news stations for them to use in their reporting. News stations love this because it saves them time and money. The victims are the American People who do not get truthful reporting.

3rd party candidates need to find qualified and interested professionals who can meet deadlines and then pay them for their services. Good luck with that.

---

They are sought out by the media for interviews. News outlets always want the latest scoop and show their audience that they can obtain interviews with high-ranking government officials. Just one call and it's Lights... Camera... Action!

Outsiders do not have access to this type of free advertising. They must beg for media attention.

---

All research, writing and design is done by their professional staff. They send out wonderfully written "legislative updates" – but in truth, these are merely brochures proclaiming their greatness. This is all paid for by you. Franklin Privileges refer to the ability for members of Congress to send out mail for free.

Outsiders are not able to steal from taxpayers.

---

They announce that will run for president just to give them more press coverage or promoting a book. This is the best type of footage for use in re-election campaigns. Plus, it helps establish themselves as leaders in their party even though they have no plans to follow through.

If a 3rd party candidate falls down, does anyone hear them?

---

They perfected the art of spinning the news and politicizing events to support the narrative that helps them get what they want. They use every opportunity to twist words and spin the news to energize contributions.

Outsiders speak the truth... obviously this is a huge disadvantage.

---

They are celebrities. They're regularly invited and seen at special events, briefings, the Whitehouse, state dinners, on Airforce One, on foreign trips, etc. All of these appearances reinforce people false beliefs that the incumbent is special.

Admiration and celebrity-ism are not thrown upon 3rd party candidates.

---

Existing legislators can sell their influence. For example, they can sell passes to the US Capital, and the flag that flies above it is given to loyal party members for them to use as "gifts" to major doners. I own such a flag.

We don't have anything to sell that anyone would want to buy.

---

The debates are only open to the 2 parties. 3<sup>rd</sup> party candidates are not allowed into the debates no matter how high they are polling.

This reinforces the misconception that 3rd party candidates are not legitimate because they are not on stage.

---

There are countless polls and surveys always being conducted. These only mention the top 2 parties because the media tells us that "they don't stand a chance anyway."

3rd party candidates are often called unelectable or nuts. 2-party candidates are respected and deemed legitimate. This is the biggest disadvantage of all.

---

## 47. Obvious Conflicts of Interest

Would someone please tell me how any of this is not a conflict of interest... or how this contributes to a fair, democratic election process?

One of the changes to our election laws that we are fighting for are equal campaign rules. If this passes, then we will finally have fair election rules, so elections will be on a level playing field once again.

Finally, challengers will not be disadvantaged any longer. They won't need to struggle building name recognition, establishing credibility, forging relationships with the media, meeting with donors and opinion leaders, finding groups interested in meeting with them and so on.

### Helping "Senior Legislators" stay in Office

Here's another trick that legislators from both parties use to stay in power. Over time, Congress has created a distinction between Senior Reps and Junior Reps.

Senior legislators get better committee assignments, fundraising, and speaking opportunities. Their titles (i.e., the majority and minority "whips") are nothing more than fancy titles given in return for loyalty.

This gives an obvious advantage to "senior legislators." Even if the incumbent is very unpopular, voters will vote for them since they don't want to lose the influence the politician has acquired during their term. This is just one more unethical practice that politicians have cleverly created to stay in power. The solution is to remove all advantages that create different categories of elected officials.

### Faking support of a bill to boost ratings

Here's yet another sleazy trick that the 2 parties use to re-elect their members. Term Limits is a good example. Most Americans want Term Limits, but no existing incumbents want them for obvious reasons. But when it comes to a vote, there are still some in Congress who voted to pass the bill. Why? Are there really honest politicians out there?

### Of course not!

So why do they vote to pass the bill? There are always politicians who face tight re-election campaigns. The party leadership will identify these legislators and allow them to vote yes in order to fake support. Consequently, voters will be fooled into thinking that the incumbent really has their interests in mind. This applies to any legislation where the people want one thing, but politicians want another.

**This is an easy way to bring awareness to 3rd parties and encourage qualified and excited individuals to run for office. We need \$75,000 to make this happen.**

#### Excellent examples of this are Amnesty International and Public Breastfeeding.

We got this idea from Amnesty International. Whenever a major human rights violation occurs anywhere in the world, or a woman is denied breastfeeding in public, an army of volunteers flood mailboxes, phones and social media.

And all this happens with just the push of a button. It really works.

#### We don’t need to twist people’s arms.

Most people want to do the right thing and are quick to cooperate.

- After all, they’re people, just like us, who also want change.
- They just don’t know that they are killing any chance for political change to happen.

Fair competition will finally allow us to hold politicians accountable by giving us more choices.

In a stunning display of hypocrisy, they are breaking the very same laws they themselves passed to prevent exactly what they are doing. But since the parties bestowed upon themselves absolute immunity, they cannot be held accountable.

And now that voters are pleading for more choices, the parties are terrified and making election laws even more unfair. They have no risk of being held accountable by voters because they know that they will win re-election... no matter what they do.

### A System this Broken Helps Us

The fact that our election system is this broken is actually very good news – because systems this ruined are easier to replace than repair.

Systems that are mildly flawed are difficult to change. Systems this corrupted are easier to replace than to repair.

When a building collapses, you don't repaint the walls – you rebuild something better. Maybe something extraordinary.

## OUR OVERALL MISSION

Our goal is to inject desperately needed competition into our election process. Our Reset Plan is 100% guaranteed to accomplish the following:

- Putting an end to our destructive two-party monopoly.
- Adopting a multi-party system of government. (See, [Top 10 benefits of a multi-party system.](#))
- Restoring meaningful voter choice, as intended under the First Amendment's protections of political association and expression.
- Eliminating structural conflicts of interest created when incumbents write the election laws that govern their own re-election.
- Reasserting the constitutional principle that government derives its legitimacy from the consent of the governed – not from self-protective election rules.
- Ensuring equal protection under the law by applying the same election rules to all candidates and parties, without favoritism or carve-outs.

- Rebuilding a lawful, competitive election framework consistent with the spirit of republican self-government envisioned by the Founders.
- Breaking the feedback loop that allows incumbents to entrench power indefinitely through legally engineered barriers to competition.
- Restoring public confidence in elections by replacing coercive “lesser-of-two-evils” outcomes with genuine majority consent.
- Reaffirming that election law exists to protect voters – not to shield officeholders from accountability.

## WHY THIS IS SO IMPORTANT

### Valid Solutions Exist – They're Just Ignored

Here's the hard truth: our country is not short on solutions. It never has been.

For every major issue facing America - healthcare, education, public safety, the environment, the economy, foreign policy, the debt - there are multiple viable solutions - many of them simple, effective, and cost-free.

### The True Goal of Legislation

In fact, on nearly every issue, there are more than just two extreme positions. Yet these solutions ever see the light of day.

Why? Because solutions are not judged on if they will work - they are judged on how much money they can raise.

- Winning re-election is their primary objective.
- Big profits mean big donations.
- Big donations mean staying in power.

### Problems that Pay Big

- War Generates Fear - and fear justifies endless military spending, expanded police powers, and permanent emergency states.
- Sickness Generates Profit - and profit fuels industries that depend on chronic illness rather than prevention or cures.

- Debt Creates Dependence - and dependence keeps voters trapped while paying profits to rich lenders.
- Division keeps People Fighting Each Other - so they never unite against the system exploiting them.

### Solutions that Don't Pay

On the other hand, outcomes like peace, health, balance, and community produce something politicians fear most: independence.

- Peace doesn't generate donations.
- Healthy people don't spend a fortune on meds.
- Balanced communities don't require constant intervention.
- Independent citizens don't respond well to fear-based messaging.

None of this will change until we change the system itself.

### Practical, Low-Cost Solutions are Hidden

And so, solutions that would actually improve quality of life - solutions that will reduce conflict, cost less money, and empower individuals—are ignored and quietly buried.

- Not because they don't WORK,
- but because they don't PAY.

This is why the same problems persist year after year. Policies that fail and are replaced with slightly renamed versions of the same failures, then fail again.

### It doesn't matter your cause. Nothing will change.

You can care about healthcare, climate change, gun safety, education, racial justice, economic inequality, immigration, civil liberties, or national security.

As long as the people writing the rules personally benefit from braking them - no solutions, no matter how rational or affordable - will be allowed to succeed.

### Election Reform isn't Just Another Issue - It is **THE ISSUE**.

- This plan matters because it doesn't fight symptoms. It fights the disease.
- It targets the incentive structure that makes failure profitable.
- Change the incentives, and behavior changes. Fix the system, and solutions finally become possible.

Everything else is just distraction and noise.

## HOW WE GOT HERE

### The Very Beginning

To understand the underlining logic of the Reset Plan, we need to go back and see what caused us to be where we are today.

Mike Jingoian started writing his book 15 years ago. Fifteen years of watching corruption deepen, elections grow more toxic, and Americans lose hope.

He began with one mission: expose what's really happening in Washington. Pull back the curtain. He believed that if Americans simply *knew the truth*, they'd reject our broken, obsolete two-party system.

### Clinton vs. Trump, 2016

But then the 2016 election happened. It smashed my assumptions about everything we thought we understood.

We ended up with the two most disliked candidates in U.S. presidential history: Hillary Clinton at 41% approval, Trump at 33%.

Meanwhile, two viable alternatives, Dr. Jill Stein (Green Party) and Gary Johnson and Bill Weld (Libertarian Party) who were both popular Republican governors in blue states, whose terms had both expired preventing them from running again.

With such low approval ratings, Michael believed that 3<sup>rd</sup> party candidates would finally put themselves on the map. But even though both Clinton and Trump were disliked by most Americans, only 5.73% of people voted for these other viable candidates.

This even includes non-swing states where a vote for a Democrat or Republican would literally make no difference at all.

The evidence shows that people don't vote for who they like most; they vote for the party they're conditioned to support.

## OUR IMMEDIATE GOAL

As you know our immediate goal is to pass these three specific changes to our election laws:

- 1. Term Limits to end Career Politicians...**  
by replacing them with people who are not for sale and will put our interests before their own.
- 2. Ranked Voting to end the Spoiler Effect...**  
so you can vote for who you want without the risk of getting your opponent elected by mistake.
- 3. Equal Laws to end the Lessor of 2 Evils...**  
by giving outsiders a fair chance to compete with both self-serving parties that deliberately make rules to prevent competition.

*Term limits were never included in the Constitution because the term "career politician" did not exist at the time. Had the Founders anticipated the greed of future politicians, they would certainly have included something about the length of time someone can grift the government.*

### We Must Have all Three Changes

These three reforms must be passed together for this plan to work. Each one addresses a different failure in our voting system, and none of them is sufficient on their own.

Passing only one or two would leave the remaining weaknesses intact and allow the system to adapt around the change. Only by implementing all three can we create a permanent solution and truly level playing field for all candidates.

Although most everyone wants these changes, voters still don't know all the [many benefits of term limits, rank voting and equal rules.](#)

## A SHARED LANGUAGE FOR REAL COMPETITION

### The Messaging Problem Finally Fixed

Beyond these three problems that need fixing, there's another problem no one has ever seriously addressed... Messaging.

Until now, there has been no coordinated effort to help 3rd parties communicate clearly, consistently, or effectively. Much of the language used in 3rd party politics is vague, academic, outdated, or simply unintuitive to everyday voters. Important concepts are poorly named, poorly explained, and poorly framed - and nearly impossible to repeat or share.

### Reset America Fixes This

Mike Jingoian – Marketer of the Year and recipient of over 400 awards in marketing – has developed an entirely new language, messaging framework, and branding strategy specifically for the 3rd party and independent movement.

For the first time, this movement is being treated like a serious national brand, not a collection of disconnected thoughts and terms.

### Tools for a National Movement

Our goal is simple: make election reform easy to understand, easy to remember, and easy to share. To do that, Reset America provides:

- A clear glossary of standardized terminology.
- Short, repeatable slogans voters can immediately grasp.
- A new, intuitive vocabulary for the 3rd party movement.
- Unified branding and visual identity.
- Clear signage and messaging tools.
- And verbatim messaging that 3rd party candidates can use directly, without translation or customization.

This is not about clever marketing for its own sake. It's about focus. If we want fair elections to become a top national priority, we must speak with one voice, using the same language, so the issue can break through media noise and voter fatigue.

### Making Fair Elections a National Priority

Our immediate objective is to elevate fair elections into the Top 6 Most Important Issues Facing Americans. That cannot happen if everyone is using different terms to describe the same problem. Consistency is how movements scale.

We know what you're thinking: "I already care about too many issues. I can't take on another one." But here's the truth – this is the only issue that actually fixes the rest of them.

### The Only Issue that Matters

Everything flows from who we elect and re-elect. Until elections are fair, no policy debate matters. Healthcare, climate, education, the economy – none of it can be resolved honestly in a system designed to protect incumbents and punish competition.

## THE ROOT PROBLEM

### Conflict of Interest

Nearly all of our nation's problems trace back to one core issue: every decision Congress makes is driven by how much money it will generate to fund increasingly expensive re-election campaigns.

This conflict stems from a deeper root cause – Congress has the power to pass laws that directly benefit themselves, most dangerously our election laws. All of this is legal because they granted themselves Absolute Immunity. As a result, they can commit acts that would send any of us to prison, without consequence.

### Reset America vs. The Democrat & Republican Parties

We are setting up a GoFundMe movement to [Sue Congress](#) for blatant violations of conflicts of Interest against the American People and the Constitution. This not only includes election laws, but absolute immunity, insider trading and more. We do not believe that Congress should be able to pass laws that affect themselves! Do you?

Our election laws shouldn't be made by the same people running in the elections. There is no more important issue than this.

## WHY INCUMBENTS NEVER LOSE

### Unfair Advantages for Incumbents

Everyone wants 3<sup>rd</sup> parties, but you need to understand that the rules are different. Most people think signatures are the only barrier – not even close. Incumbents have countless advantages (both unethical and illegal), all protected by absolute immunity.

Here are just some of the [unfair advantages](#) that we've experienced first-hand. There are certainly many more, and the most damaging ones are intentionally concealed from the public.

### Signature Gathering: The First Barrier

Signature gathering is one of the most effective ways to block competition. In 2008, we produced a video called, "[Kiss Freedom Goodbye](#)" that brought some these atrocities to light. It was honored with these awards.



- The Telly Award for Best Internet Commercial for Political Issues
- The W3 Award for Best Viral Marketing Video for Activism
- The Marcom Award for Best Political Web Video
- The Ava Award for Best New Political Video

**Here are some facts included in the video.**

- As we've already noted, the rules are not the same. In some states, 3rd parties are required to gather up to 10 times more signatures than Democratic or Republican candidates.
- If just one signature is invalid, the entire sheet is thrown out, instantly wiping out dozens of legitimate signatures. This makes campaigns easy to sabotage and nearly impossible to defend.
- In Connecticut, the Libertarian Party was short 321 signatures, while state officials freely admitted that they had lost 119 pages of bona fide signatures.
- In Pennsylvania, if the petition doesn't have enough signatures, the candidate must pay court costs upwards of \$100,000. This is what caused the closure of the Reform Party.
- In some states, candidates must get up to 100,000 signatures to get on a ballot.
- In some cases, the people collecting signatures can only be from THAT state or they will get thrown into federal prison. (Is there any crime worse than collecting signatures?)

**Designed to Fail**

This burden is not accidental. Gathering signatures is difficult, time-consuming, and expensive – and the two parties know it. That is precisely why they impose near-impossible signature requirements: not to protect voters, but to prevent competition.

**A Problem Technology Solved Years Ago**

What's more, the process itself is intentionally outdated. Voters are asked to hand over personal information to complete strangers, even during a pandemic. Predictably, many people refuse.

And yet, despite modern online verification systems, states still insist this process must be done on paper - when it can easily be handled through a simple online form.

**So, who is this really meant to benefit?**

1. Voters who are trying to access real choices, fair competition, and a system that actually reflects their will?
2. Or the politicians who wrote these rules to shield themselves from challengers to guarantee their own re-election – regardless of performance or public approval?

**Protecting your Voting Rights**

The 2 parties create steep hurdles that prevent you from voting for candidates outside the 2 parties. Many of these are illegal. So, 3rd Parties are forced to use their limited funds to fight for your right to vote for whom you want.

3<sup>rd</sup> parties are constantly suing states and the federal government to defend against illegal campaign practices that prevent any competition from taking hold.

**Cases are Seldom Lost**

Most of these cases are either won or they are thrown out by judges who were appointed by the 2 parties and whose careers are influenced by their decisions. Over the years, there have been over 100 lawsuits brought by 3rd party and other independent groups. We are unaware of any cases that were lost based on the merits.

As we said, this is why we never see ads for 3<sup>rd</sup> party candidates. All their money is spent trying to get their names on ballots and defending your right to vote for who you want.

There are simply no funds left over for the important activities that 2 major parties take for granted, like fundraising, promoting candidates, outreach and recruitment, candidate development, volunteer networking, media development and so on and so on.

## ILLOGICAL VOTING BEHAVIOR

### Conflicting Voting Decisions

The data reveals some heartbreaking contradictions.

- 85% of voters dislike our government but still support the same two parties.
- 80% demand Term Limits, yet we re-elect the same corrupt politicians 95% of the time.
- 75% want 3rd parties, yet we cling to the lie that “voting for a 3rd party is a wasted vote.”

We are a nation saying that we want one thing while we do the complete opposite.

- This is NOT because we’re *irrational*.
- It Is because we’re trapped in a system designed to make us *behave irrationally*.

Why do we say one thing but do the other? It is because when we think for ourselves, we think one way – but when we think about what the herd will do, we think entirely differently. Many of these unconscious psychological pressures are covered in the book, *Mistaken Beliefs*. (Our gift when you [Join Reset America](#).)

## THE SPOILER EFFECT

### Their Psychological Trap

Let’s be honest: the spoiler effect is real, and it continues to paralyze voters with fear.

Most Americans agree that our system is broken beyond repair... yet we still vote for the same corrupt career politicians and two-parties because we’re terrified of inadvertently “helping the other side win.”

The Spoiler Effect forces voters into the same trap every election:

- We DON'T vote for who we WANT.
- We VOTE AGAINST who we want LESS.

That’s not voting. That’s the “Lessor of 2 Evils.” It’s a psychological trap that is purposely designed to keep the same career politicians and parties in power... Forever.

- No Choices.
- No Competition.
- No Accountability.
- Only Fear.

## WE’RE NOT TELLING YOU HOW TO VOTE

The brilliance of this plan is that it does not ask you to vote one way or another. You can vote for anyone you want. Seriously. Real change doesn’t begin by forcing people to betray their values - it begins by creating a system where you can vote your conscience without fear of accidentally helping the candidate you oppose the most.

You may also expect us to plead to you to vote only for non-Democrat or non-Republican candidates. That’s not what we’re going to do either.

This plan is far more strategic – and far more realistic – than simply telling people to vote a particular way... at least not yet. We’re not trying to change voting behavior – we’re changing the rules that punish voters who think for themselves – and not persuaded by the herd.

### The Hard Truth about Voting Behavior

Why would anyone who has spent their life fighting for voting rights say that? Because people will not vote for a non-Democrat or non-Republican candidate – even if their life depended on it. That reality isn’t a moral failure; it’s the predictable result of rules designed to trap voters in fear.

There are two reasons this trap remains so powerful.

1. The Spoiler Effect is locked in. It is non-negotiable - *until Ranked Voting is passed*.
2. The public clings to the deeply ingrained lie that “voting for a third party is a wasted vote.”

Together, these forces paralyze voters and protect the two-party monopoly – no matter how dissatisfied the public becomes.

This plan starts by acknowledging that reality, not denying it. Only by removing the fear and fixing the rules can voting honestly become possible.

## “VOTING FOR A 3RD PARTY IS A WASTED VOTE”

In 2017, Michael was considering heading the Libertarian and Green parties – but after the results from the 2016 presidential election, he realized that no amount of education could break this dangerous mistaken belief planted in the American consciousness.

### The Most Successful Lie in American Politics

This deeply rooted lie has done more damage than any of the other lie they try to make us believe. It’s the glue that keeps the monopoly intact. And it was the original title of *Mistaken Beliefs*.

And voting for the two parties isn’t just “wasted” – it’s actively damaging, because every such vote reinforces the very monopoly that is rigging the system against us.

It signals acceptance of rules designed to eliminate competition, reward corruption, and punish alternatives.

As long as voters keep strengthening this monopoly, the parties have no incentive to change anything – and no reason to fear accountability.

We fought for Independence against a corrupt Monarchy.

Now we must fight for Freedom against our corrupt two parties.

## RANKED VOTING MUST COME FIRST

Ranked Voting is the Reset Button that will end the Spoiler Effect forever – and it’s why most modern democracies use it. (See, [Top 10 benefits of a multi-party system](#).) Without it, voters will remain trapped in this rigged game purposely designed to keep two-party politicians in power forever... and up until now, it’s worked flawlessly. This is why ranked voting must be passed FIRST.

Politicians will tell you it’s “complicated”... but it’s not. (Yeah, they lie - can you believe it?)

- You rank your choices.
- If your first choice loses, your vote moves to your next choice.

As soon as a candidate receives a majority of the vote (50% or higher) the counting is over.

- No Delays.
- No Wasted Votes.
- No Lesser-of-two-evils.
- No “Holy smokes, I just got the other side elected!”

### Why We Don’t Use It?

So, if Ranked Voting is so effective, why don’t we use it? Both parties are terrified of it – because the moment Ranked Voting is adopted, the two-party monopoly begins to collapse. It removes their ability to scare voters into compliance and replaces fear with real choice.

## HOW DOES ANY LAW GET PASSED?

Then, we asked ourselves, how does any law get passed by Congress? The answer is simple: whatever helps them stay in power, which usually means whoever pays them the most money.

So, just like any other bill, we will play by following the same rules.

## We are Realists

You may think that changing our election laws is impossible since politicians won't vote themselves out of the easiest (and most powerful) job in the world - and you'd be right. But we have a plan that's assured to succeed.

How can we make such a claim? Simple. We will use the same unethical and criminal practices that Congress uses - but this time to work for us.

Here's the hard reality - nothing moves through Congress unless it directly benefits its' members. And this means cash... donations to finance their lifestyle and their expensive re-election campaigns.

## OUR "FOOLPROOF" PLAN

**This isn't wishful thinking. It's a well-conceived plan that's based in reality.**

Our mission is the same as it has always been, break our destructive two-party monopoly by restoring competition and fairness to our elections. But over the years, our specific strategy has evolved.

This plan is deliberately simple, realistic, and measurable. It's built step by step, grounded in how Congress actually works - not how we wish it worked.

Each phase is designed to be easy to understand, easy to track, and based on incentives politicians already respond to.

There's no guesswork, no idealism, and no reliance on sudden moral awakenings, just a practical strategy that uses the system's own mechanics to force change.

### Playing the Game Means Knowing the Rules

Someone will need to push this bill through Congress - someone who knows the system and can speak fluent "congress." You can't beat the system unless you understand the forces that drive it.

Mike Jingoian (a.k.a. Gozian) has many years of experience as an award-winning marketing psychologist and has dedicated his life to understanding exactly what those motivators are.

And the truth? We have not yet met a single person – from far left to far right – who doesn't instantly understand this message and agree with this plan.

Reset America has a single, narrow purpose: unite Americans around the specific changes that break the rigged mechanics of our elections – so real accountability, real competition, and real choice become possible again.

- Ending the 'Spoiler Effect'.
